We had two interesting talks in February.

First Norma Porter spoke about her 'Grandads Dog', who managed to get himself from England to France during the first World War and found his master in the trenches – quite an amazing feat. He was wounded twice, returned to England and then raised funds for Red Cross for many years.

Then Jenny Sew Hoy Agnew & Trevor Agnew spoke about their research into the life of Jenny's Great-Great-Grandfather, Choie Sew Hoy, who came from China during the Otago Goldrush, where he was one of the first merchants. They have produced a book about his journey. It was a very good talk with some tips on how to go about researching generations past.

They particularly recommend using "Papers Past", newspapers which have been digitalised.

These are available online or they recommend the Main library, where people have been trained, by the Agnews, to help in this research.
